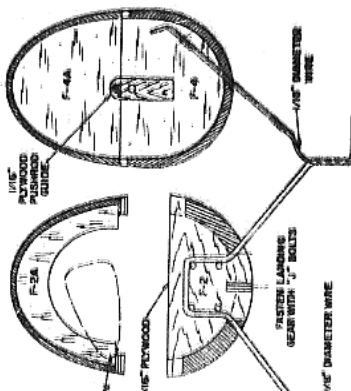
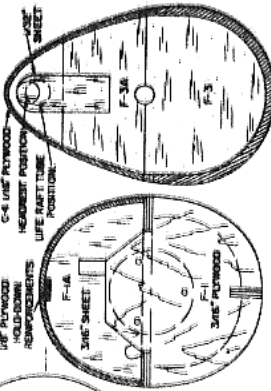




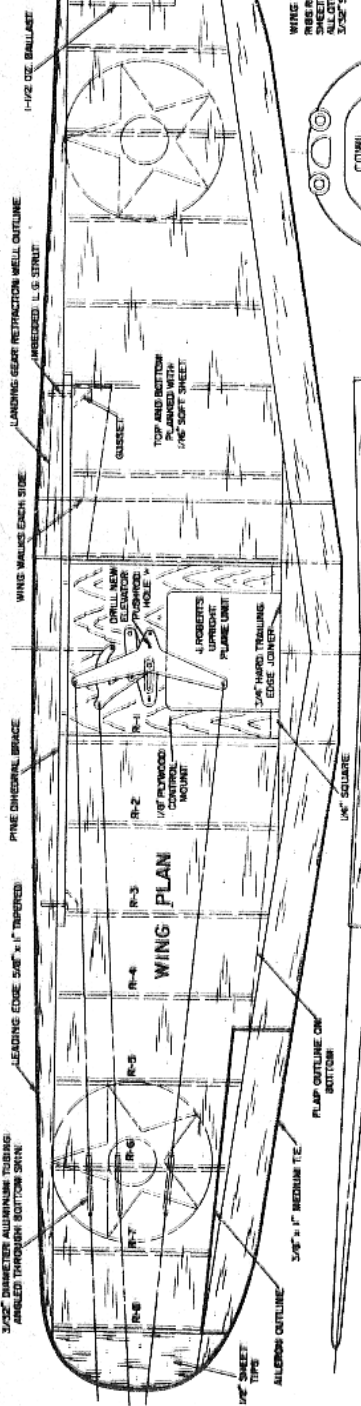
RIB LAYOUTS
